Contingency arrangements for exams for students taking qualifications in summer 2022

The government is clear that students entering GCSEs in 2022 will be taking exams in the summer and complete any non-exam assessments in the usual way throughout the year.

In recognition of the fact that students' education has been disrupted by the pandemic, they will be given extra help to prepare for their exams as follows:

- Students taking GCSEs in English literature, history, ancient history and geography will not need to cover the usual range of content in the exams teachers will support students to learn and revise the appropriate content, this has been released on the exam board websites on the 7^{th of} February 2022 (see link below)
- Students taking GCSE mathematics will be given in their exams copies of formulae they would in other years have to memorise
- Students taking GCSE physics and combined science will be given in their exams a sheet covering all the equations they might need to apply in the exams

- All Period 6 sessions will be continuing for another 6 weeks after school, you should have been sent a letter about this and will receive another update soon if your daughter is taking part in these sessions.

Equipment

School will no longer be providing students with equipment for your daughter's exams, other than the exam papers themselves. Therefore, your daughter will need to bring her own equipment. She will need:

- **Compulsory:** Black biro pens, pencil, clear 30cm ruler, rubber, pencil sharpener and a highlighter
- Optional: Pencil case (must be clear)
